





#### **Abstract submissions - outcome**

- 770 abstracts submitted!
  - Thank you for all your efforts to promote your track and the conference as a whole!!!
- This allows us to be selective and accept only papers of good quality.
- Even more important to stress that we (Mats & Mats) make the final decisions as there are logistical constraints (we are looking into those at the moment).
- Between 0 and 50 abstracts received per track.
  - Maximum: 36 presentation within one track
- In the next few days:
  - Some abstracts may be moved from "General submission" to specific tracks.
  - Some small tracks might be merged with others

### **Abstract handling**

- Track chairs organize the review process of their track submissions:
  - Each abstract should be reviewed by at least two reviewers
  - Track chair organizers can perform reviews (but not on their own papers)
  - Important to keep deadline (March 13) as the timeline is tight
- Decision about acceptance/reject is made by the organizers (Mats & Mats)

You will find all assigned abstracts in the list on the Review page.

Click an abstract title in the list and the full abstract text will be loaded on the right.

Read the abstract and then complete the Review section below the text and click Save review.

If you have any conflict of interest with the current abstract then you click the "Conflict of interest" button instead of completing the Review section.

Repeat the steps above for each abstract.
